

## Getting to Wimbledon from Gatwick Airport



### By Train

From the rail station at Gatwick there are two options:

- The most convenient way is to take a **Southern** train to **Clapham Junction** (**NOT the Gatwick Express**). This takes about 25 minutes. Change at Clapham Junction to platform 11 for a train to **Wimbledon**, about 10 minutes. This costs around **£12** one way. (**From January 2016**, passengers travelling between London and Gatwick Airport will be able to use pay as you go with **Oyster cards\*** and **contactless at a cost of £8 off-peak**)

- The more frequent **Gatwick Express** is a non-stop train to **Victoria** which takes 30 minutes. It costs around **£20** but can be cheaper if you buy online <http://www.gatwickexpress.com/en/>.

**Change at Victoria** to the Underground **District Line** to Wimbledon. Make sure you get a **Wimbledon train south-bound** (it should say Wimbledon on the front of the train), and get off at Wimbledon station which is the last stop (**30 minutes**)

Single fare is **£4.90 (cash)**.

Single fare **with an Oystercard\*** **£2.80** (Saturday/Sunday/Bank Holidays)

From the station we advise you take a **taxi to your homestay**, it should cost between **£5 and £15**.



### By Coach

From the coach station at Gatwick, there are coaches to **Central London (Victoria Coach station)**. The journey takes 1 hour 35 minutes and costs around **£8** one way.

There are National Express <http://www.nationalexpress.com/home.aspx> ticket desks in the North and South Terminals.

From **Victoria Coach station** walk ten minutes to **Victoria Underground station**. Then take the Underground **District Line** to Wimbledon. Make sure you get a **Wimbledon train south-bound** (it should say Wimbledon on the front of the train) and get off at Wimbledon station, the last stop (**30 minutes**)

Single fare is **£4.90 (cash)**.

Single fare **with an Oystercard\*** **£2.80** (Saturday/Sunday/Bank Holidays)

From the station we advise you take a taxi to your homestay, it should cost between **£5 and £15**.

You may be able to find cheaper buses from the airport, for example **easybus**, by booking online at <http://www.easybus.com/en/london-gatwick>
